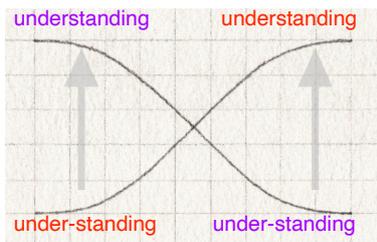


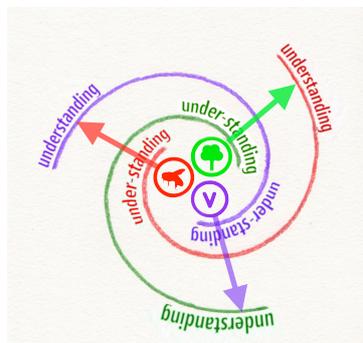


We described the principle of bi-versal understanding [bee-violet-] by drawing two curved lines that literally cross over and stand under each other [symmetrical under-standing] on the two dimensional surface...



But in order to describe the principle of tri-versal [and symmetrical] singularity of understanding **bee-tree-violet-**, where each literally stands under the others on a two dimensional surface, we must rearrange the lines with the notional 'bottom of the picture' being in the middle and the 'top of the picture' being around the edge.

The diagram at the top of the next column describes in principle, a three-fold understanding in which **bee** understands **tree** and **violet**, **violet** understands **bee** and **tree**, **tree** understands **violet** and **bee**. Let us call this symmetrical tri-verse of singularity **bee(treeviolet)-tree(violetbee)-violet(bee tree)**. Each of the three, [**bee**, **tree** and **violet**] are constituent things of the **bee-tree-violet-** tri-versal thing.



The question is, what do the constituents of the tri-verse experience in comprehending and thus be-coming real as the other two? Take **bee** for example - **bee** is real as **treeviolet**. But inasmuch as this is the singularity of understanding, **tree** and **violet** cannot simply be 'out there waiting' to be-come **bee**. **Tree** and **violet** must always already be the constituents of a bi-versal understanding of the type that we have been describing.

So we can say that **tree** is real as **violet** and that **violet** is real as **tree** - in other words **bee** is real as (**tree** which is real as (**violet**)), and also **bee** is real as (**violet** which is real as (**tree**)). [We use the convention of curved brackets to denote a 'grasping together' ~ literally a comprehending of the others and thereby be-coming real with the others spatio-temporally.]

To recap, at the elementary moment, **bee** is real as **treeviolet**, but because of the factor of singularity [that we met before p40] **tree** is [always] already real as **violet** and **violet** is [always] already real as **tree**, which means the thing which was at the elementary moment **bee(treeviolet)** has in the first moment of realisation [always] already become **bee(tree(violet)violet(tree))**.

How does **bee** experience the two other constituents which are always already real as each other?

Bee experiences everything that they [always] already are as a **gravity**. **Bee** experiences precisely what **tree** experiences as **violet** plus what **violet** experiences as **tree** - which is a gravitational pull in the ratio of **1 : (1+1)**.

In other words bee feels the gravity of tree and violet because bee actually is tree and violet.

Tree feels the gravity of violet and bee because tree actually is violet and bee.

Violet feels the gravity of bee and tree because violet actually is bee and tree.
